

The 2nd ANNUAL MEDALLION CONGRESS July 2015

The Hilton Hotel Warwick Saturday July 11th 2015

Following the success of the first Congress held in June 2014, and with the unanimous agreement of all attending, a repeat, of what it is hoped will become an annual event, is to be held in 2015. Collectors and others with an interest in commemorative and historical medallions are invited to attend in Warwick in July 2015 to share ideas and information in a sociable forum.

The daylong event will, again, be staged at the Hilton Hotel, Warwick – this is conveniently located on the A429 within 200 yards of junction 15 on the M40.

The programme will consist of a number of talks and discussions on medallion related subjects and proceedings will conclude with a meal in the hotel restaurant followed by a bourse at which delegates will have the opportunity to sell, buy and exchange. It is anticipated that the Congress will commence at 10.30 a.m. and close at around 10.00 p.m.

The cost will, as for 2014, be £60 for the whole day, to include all refreshments, lunch, evening meal and parking.

Those wishing to stay overnight on the Saturday, in order to enjoy a leisurely Sunday in neighbouring Warwick or Stratford Upon Avon, can do so at the following rates: Overnight accommodation at the hotel is available to Congress delegates a £135 for a single room, to include Congress attendance (as above), room and breakfast. For double rooms the cost will be £195. In 2015 there is the added advantage for those staying on Saturday night of being able to attend the Coin Fair to be held at the National Motor Cycle Museum on Sunday, 12th; this is located only 30km (19m) north along the M40/M42 at Jnc.6 on the M42. For delegates who may wish to stay on the preceding Friday night bed and breakfast at the hotel is available at £90 for a single room and £100 for a double.

A deposit of £25 per head will be required with the balance being due by Friday 12th June 2015.

An early response is advised (especially if overnight accommodation is required). If you collect or are interested in historical medallions please try and support this event so that it can now become an established annual occasion.
